- G. Edwin Augustus Hannaford b Oct. 12, 1841 Widdecombe in the Moor, England d Granbury, Texas m Nettie Brouse. Fought Civil War, private. Hannaford moved from Cincinnati to Granbury, Texas in 1871. In 1999 a Texas Historical Medallion was placed at 130 N. Houston St., Granbury to commemorate his drugstore, which started in a tent. Later, he partnered with J.D. Baker and built a stone joint commercial building, one of the earliest stone structures in Granbury. "Doc" Hannaford was a well known businessman and civic leader. His drugstore was also a bookstore.

HANNAFORD - MITCHELL

There is a possible link between Richard S. Hannaford, Sr. born April 1785 in Devonshire, England, who lived in Cincinnati, and Roger Hannaford (and therefore Samuel) who were born in Widdecombe in the Moor, Devonshire, England. I assume they were some degree of cousins. Richard came to the U. S. in the 1820's, Richard S., Jr. was naturalized in Brookville, Indiana and came to Cincinnati. Richard S., Sr's. family was in the 1840 Crosby Twp, Hamilton Co., Ohio census (Harrison).

According to Barbara Kettler (Ancestry.com, Hannaford board) from a book written about Nemaha Co., Nebraska history: "Richard S. Hannaford, son of Richard S. And Harriett Hannaford, was born in the borough of Plymouth, England on August 8, 1818. He was baptized in St. Charles and during his infancy he traveled with his parents to the United States where they settled in Indiana. In 1826, he moved his family to Cincinnati, Ohio. Richard S. had two brothers, James and William, who also settled in Nebraska, and seven sisters who remained in Ohio. Richard S. Hannaford learned the trade of cabinet maker and worked for fifteen years for 'Mitchell, Ramilsburg and Co' (sic) a furniture store located in Cincinnati, Ohio. Richard S. Arrived in Brownville, Nebraska Territory, April 1855 by steamboat, under the command of Captain Whyte from St. Louis. He homesteaded five miles west of Brownville..." He died in Litchfield, Nebraska in Sept. 1897.
